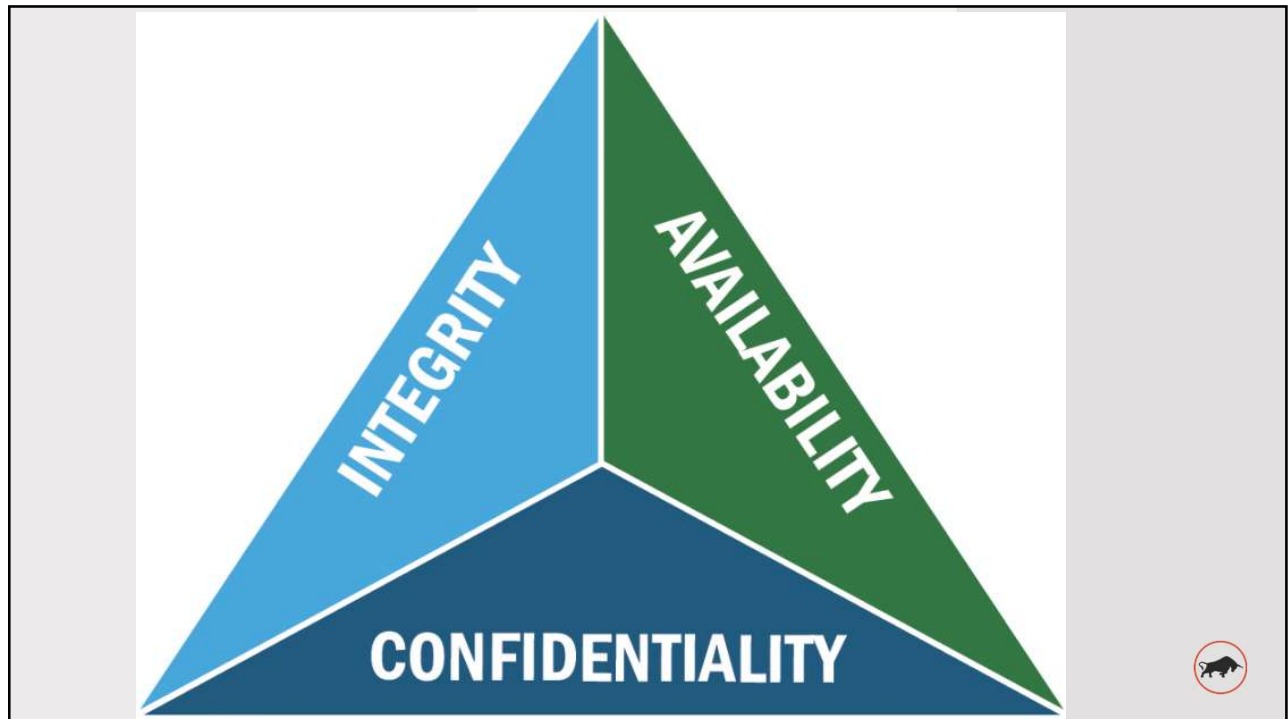

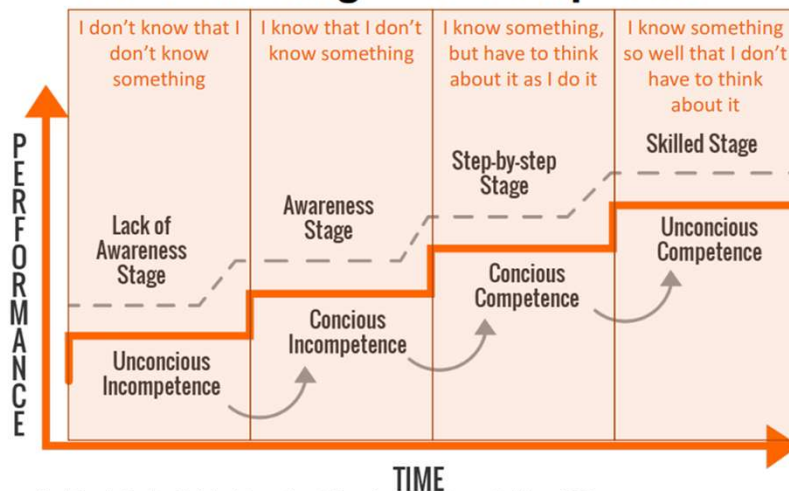
Supply Chain (typical reaction)
