KEYNOTE #1

THE COST OF BEING "DIGITALLY EXCLUDED" Nicol Turner-Lee, Brookings Institute

Dr. Nicol Turner Lee is a fellow in the Brookings Institute's Governance Program's Center for Technology Innovation where she researches public policy designed to enable equitable access to technology across the U.S. and to harness its power to create change in communities across the world.
